POOL RULES

- No lifeguard on duty
- No diving
- No coolers, or outside food & beverage permitted on pool deck, including cabanas
- No glass permitted in pool or on pool deck or in cabanas
- No animals permitted in pool or on pool deck or in cabanas
- Please, no fishing poles on pool deck or in cabanas
- Bathing load: 70
- Pool Hours: 9am to dusk
- Shower before entering pool
- Children under 12 years of age should have adult supervision
- People with health problems should not use pool without consulting a doctor first
- Do not use pool if under the influence of drugs or alcohol
- No swimming allowed after dusk, or during severe weather, including heavy rain, thunder, and lightning
- Umbrellas must be closed when winds or gusts exceed 12 mph
- Swim diapers must be used for appropriate swimmers
- Please, use the restrooms for changing of clothes and diapers
- For safety reasons, please do not move chairs, or umbrellas

Slide specific rules:

- Swim at own risk – NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY
- Must be 48" tall to use slides
- Riders must wait for signal of slide attendant before sliding
- Failure to obey rules will result in discontinued use
- Single riders only – children cannot ride in the lap of an adult
- Slide feet first in a seated or laying down position only
- No stopping, turning/twisting, or rapid succession of sliding
- Keep the bottom of the slide clear, exit quickly to the side and exit pool - DO NOT CROSS IN FRONT OF SLIDES
- No flotation devices with zippers or buckles permitted
- No Swimwear with exposed zippers, buckles, rivets, or metal ornamentation (such as belts or chains) permitted
- No eyewear, including masks or goggles permitted (risk of injury)
- Please remove jewelry (watches, chains, bracelets, large earrings, etc...) prior to riding
- No casts permitted for risk of damage and injury
- No cameras permitted down slide
