For the safety of our guests and staff, and consistent with Centers of Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidance, we ask all persons who believe they may have COVID-19, or who are awaiting test results for COVID-19 to refrain from checking into the hotel until they are cleared by a medical professional. #### **Beach Nourishment Project Update:**

South Seas Island Resort is currently a part of the 2021 Beach Nourishment Project conducted by Captiva Erosion Prevention District. The project will greatly benefit the foliage, create natural dunes, increase the quality of the beaches for recreational purposes as well as protect against natural erosion and storms. Currently the project is stationed at our South Beach and is expected to be present during the next 7 days. It is expected to be completed by mid-October.

Please be mindful of the work crews while on the beach. Their job is to keep our residents and resort guests safe during the project. If you come upon caution tape or temporary fencing, you may be re-routed. Please utilize the provided sand bridges to reach points on the beach that are beyond the pipeline. We will send updates once we receive them from the Executive Director of CEPD. Thank you for your patience and cooperation during this time.
